#### SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (page 146 RRS 2021-2024).

#### RULES

**SSI 1** Restricted speed on the Waikato River and entrance to Lake Taupo.

#### NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

The official notice board is located in the window at the clubhouse entrance of the Lake Taupo Yacht Club.

#### SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

**SSI 3** Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at Lake Taupo Yacht Club

**SSI 4** When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

**SSI 6** On Monday 18<sup>th</sup> April no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs

### **COURSES (SI 7)**

**SSI 7** The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Addendum A.

**SSI 8** In the event that a gate mark is missing and has not been replaced with an object displaying flag M, the remaining mark shall be rounded to port.

### **MARKS (SI 8)**

**SSI 9** The description of the marks is shown in the table in Addendum A – Courses.

### **THE START (SI 9)**

**SSI 10** When a starting sequence is in progress, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as the area 50 metres from the starting line and marks in all directions.

**SSI 11** A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and 5.2.

**SSI 12** If any part of a boat's hull is on the course side of the starting line at her starting signal and she is identified, the race committee will attempt to broadcast her name and/or sail number on VHF channel 77. Failure to make a broadcast, failure of her to hear such a broadcast, or the order in which boats are broadcast will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

### **TIME LIMITS (SI 12)**

### **PENALTY SYSTEM**

**SSI 13** For all Trailer Yacht classes rule 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

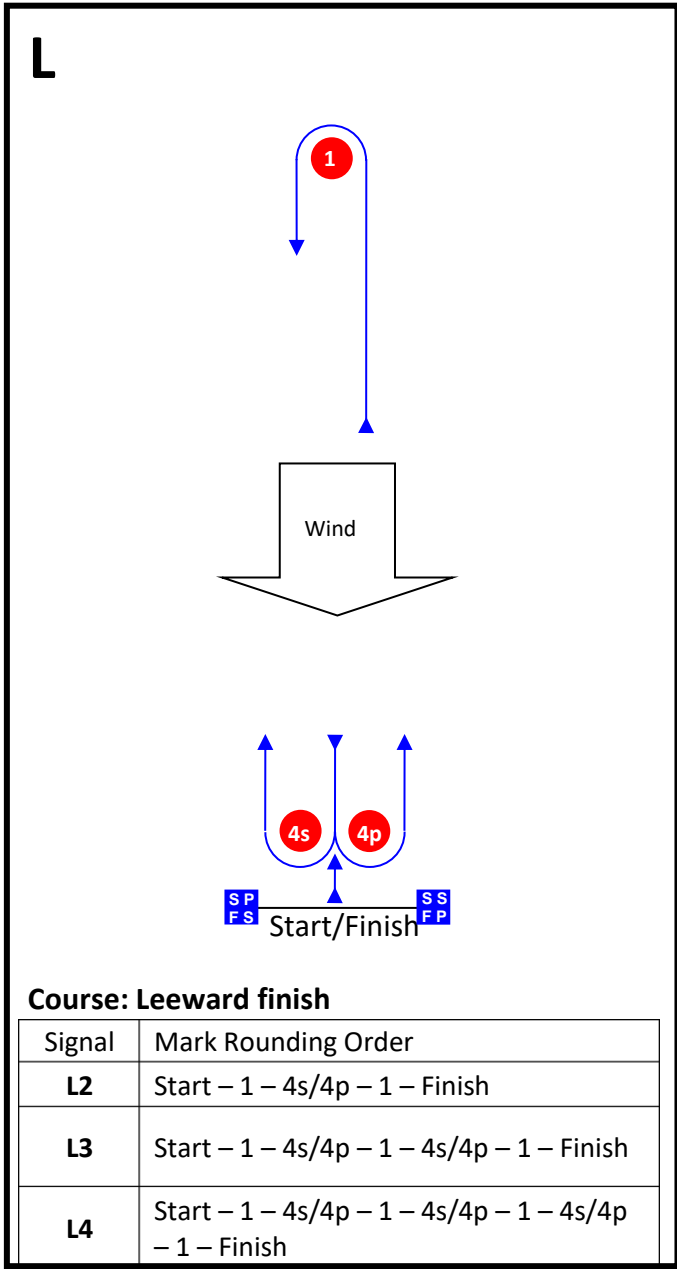
### **CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN**

**SSI 14** Boats shall comply with the check out and check in procedure which will be described at the briefing on Friday 15 April at 1100hrs.

**SUPPORT VESSELS**

**SSI 15** All official and support vessels shall always have an engine safety cut out switch (kill cord) attached to the driver while the engine is running, unless prior written exemption has been provided by the Organising Authority.
